Dear B Team Parents:

All we can say is **WOW!!!**

Actually, we need to say a lot more than that. Your son/daughter's team is now only one game away from the **2008 National Pop Warner Super Bowl**. If they win the next game on Saturday, November 29th the boys will definitely be going to Walt Disney World. The decision to send the girls is pending fundraising efforts. We still need a lot of help in that regard, so everyone should be contacting Cary Nevins today to volunteer for fundraising.

Although final travel arrangements are still being made, and we still have one game left to win, the plan right now is to leave on Sunday, December 7th and return on Saturday December 13th.

We will be speaking with Mr. O'Rourke at the Middle School regarding the trip and asking that teachers help with providing advance work for the students. We will not however be speaking with individual teachers and/or actually collecting the assignments. This is the responsibility of you and your child. We have enclosed a letter that should be provided to your child's teachers to assist with this effort. As part of the requirement by national Pop Warner, your child must attend mandatory daily study halls while in Walt Disney world. They will be supervised and we are planning to reserve them for two hours each weekday.

Attached are agreement forms and waivers which need to be completed, signed by **BOTH** parents and the child and returned, along with a photocopy of both sides of your child's health insurance card, before Monday, December 1st. **If the forms are not returned to your Team Manager before Monday December 1st your child will not be making the trip with us.**

You and your child will also need to work with the Team Manager on room assignments. Our plan is to have one chaperone in each hotel room with two or three children. The rooms each have two double beds and chaperones will only be sharing beds with their own children (chaperones with children not in the program will have their own double bed with two children sharing the second double bed). You and your child will need to work with the Team Manager to arrange the children and chaperone you wish to stay with. The choice of chaperone and final decision on rooming arrangements is up to us, but we will make every effort to accommodate your requests. **The rooming arrangements need to be worked out before Sunday November 30<sup>th</sup>. The chaperone staying in the same room as your child must be listed on the Parental Travel and Medical Consent Form.**

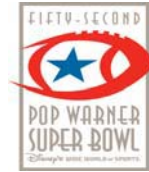

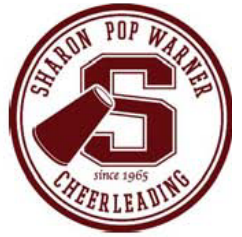

**Travel Consent:**

1. I hereby authorize the Child to travel with the Traveling Guardian(s) to Walt Disney World in Lake Buena Vista, Florida for the purpose of participating in the 2008 Pop Warner National Super Bowl.

## Responsibility Contract
